The Lupus Foundation of America (LFA), Georgia Chapter strives to put a spotlight on the devastating effects of lupus with several statewide resources, including:

- Our signature statewide **Lupus Empowerment Series**, which will bring educational symposiums and seminars in cities across Georgia from the fall of 2019 through 2020.
- Our annual **Atlanta Empowerment Summit** with national and local speakers, more than 300 attendees and breakout sessions presented in both English and Spanish.
- An **emergency financial assistance program** that offers up to \$500 per year per applicant so that lupus patients don't have to choose between paying their light bill and buying their medications.
- A robust **advocacy network**, including more than 885 e-advocates who engage and educate federal, state and local elected officials about the cruel mystery of lupus. Our annual Advocacy Day at the Georgia State Capitol provides an empowering opportunity to meet with representatives and share personal stories. We also participate in the biennial Lupus Advocacy Summit in Washington, D.C.
- **Newly-diagnosed seminars** led by medical experts who provide information on lupus, its symptoms, treatments, and coping techniques to new members of the lupus community.
- A **support group network** of more than 30 groups across the state that meet monthly to offer support, fellowship and resources.
- Our Hispanic support group, which offers **materials and assistance in Spanish**, is a lifeline to an underserved community in need of resources and support.

For many living with lupus, the greatest challenge is a lack of understanding. Patients often feel they are the only ones who "don't look sick." The Chapter is a lifeline. We are here to listen and to make sure everyone with lupus receives answers and support. Ninety cents of every dollar donated funds our programs, resources and advocacy here in Georgia. We also support the national research efforts to fund and advocate for investment in lupus.

The Chapter and the national LFA are leading the way. Join us in the fight to end lupus.





- Lupus affects more than **55,000 Georgians and 1.5 million Americans**, mostly women aged 18-45 but also men, children and women of all ages.
- Lupus affects **more than** the combined number of those affected by MS, cystic fibrosis, cerebral palsy, sickle cell anemia, leukemia and HIV.
- Lupus is an **unpredictable**, life-diminishing and life-devastating autoimmune disease which can affect any organ system, skin, joints, kidneys, brain, heart, lungs and blood.
- Lupus is difficult to diagnose and is very misunderstood in the medical and lay community.
- Lupus is three times more likely to strike minorities, including African-Americans, Hispanics and Asians.
- There is no known cause or cure and the incidence of lupus has increased in the past 20 years.
