

Dr. Madaio was appointed Chairman of the Department of Medicine at the Medical College of Georgia at Augusta University in 2008. Dr. Madaio's nephrology practice focuses on immunologically mediated renal diseases, particularly, systemic lupus erythematosus, glomerulonephritis and nephrotic syndrome. An NIH funded researcher for over 25 years, Dr. Madaio has an active laboratory focused on systemic autoimmunity immunologic mechanisms of renal disease. His laboratory is currently pursuing novel mechanisms of targeting drug delivery to the kidney to treat ongoing inflammation, and development of novel imaging techniques to assess kidney function. As a nationally and internationally recognized clinician and researcher Dr. Madaio has served on NIH, AHA and other scientific study sections, pharma advisory boards, national task forces, and organizing committees for national and international conferences, and he has been a member of editorial boards for nephrology and autoimmunity journals.
